

The wonder of Easter is upon us. We will celebrate together as a church family on Palm Sunday, Good Friday night and Easter Sunday morning. #### **WMU Meetings at SFBC**


April 1-Jean Albright Circle, Chapel 7:00 p.m. April 2-Mary Sampson Circle, Chapel 10:00 a.m.


