
SEND THE GOSPEL TO THE ENDS OF THE EARTH

groups are yet unreached and hundreds of remote Pacific islands. Shoeboxes are used by local churches to share the Good News of Jesus



Options to Participate

- 1. Pack a shoebox or several! Our goal is 250. Bring them to the church by November 14 when they will be prayed over in the service.
- 2. Build a shoebox online through Samaritan's Purse. It is \$25 per box and they will pack the shoeboxes for you. These shoeboxes go to a hard to access region around the world.
- 3. Pray for the children who will receive these gift-filled shoeboxes.


I had friends from Richmond here a few weeks ago. You made them feel very welcome at SFBC. They have continued to lavish praise on you for your hospitality.
