




## A word from your pastor....

We have to be intentional in combating the inevitable draw to see the season in the wrong light. Here are some suggestions to help us remain focused.

- 1. Make the Scripture central in your Advent journey. Read one chapter from the Gospel of Luke daily during December. You will finish the 24 chapters on Christmas Eve.
- 2. Give to the Lottie Moon Christmas Offering. Our goal is \$30,000. Go to imb.org/weekofprayer to learn the stories of our international missionaries. They depend on us.

3. Don't allow disappointments to turn into bitterness. Ask God to free you of that weight. That may be the best present you receive this year.


