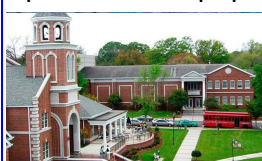

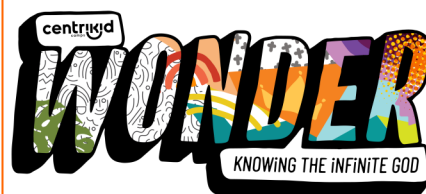

## *A word from your pastor....*

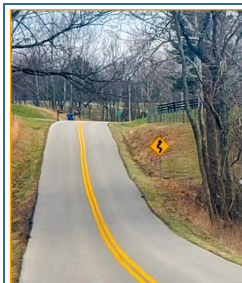

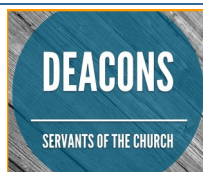
