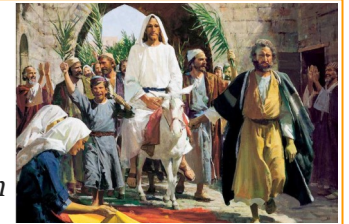
Holy Week Celebration

"I give you a new commandment: Love one another as I have loved you." John 13:34

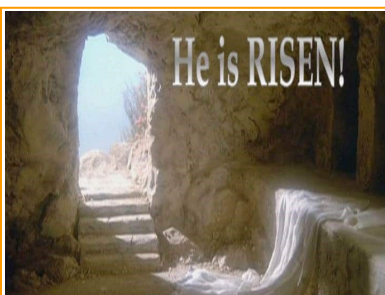
Good Friday Service

Your paid registration required by All are welcome! Friday, April 22.

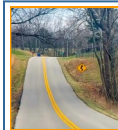

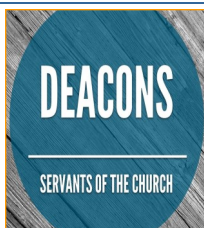
