Only 4 states have a higher percentage of children living in poverty. For many children in KY, a backpack from KY Baptists may be all they get for Christmas!

All backpacks collected here will be distributed directly to children living in poverty in Stearns, KY. Bible Fellowship classes and individuals are encouraged to participate by filling backpacks.

We are also collecting filled diaper bags packed with baby items to distribute.

How to Participate & Pack:

- 1. Start with a new, zippered backpack. These are available at the church office, or you can purchase your own.
- 2. Determine the gender & age for each backpack.
- 3. Fill your backpacks with NEW gifts.
- 4. Pray specifically for each recipient child & their family.
- 5. Deliver backpacks to the church by collection date.

These Items are Required: (Age Appropriate)

- **Toys (at least 1):** Small cars, balls, dolls, stuffed animals, etc.
- Hygiene Items (at least 2): Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, etc.
- Souther (at least 2): Bible, books, toy jewelry, flashlight, etc.)
- Food (at least 2): Canned food items with pop-tops, protein bars, hard candy, lollipops, suckers, gum; NO chocolate, peanut butter or nuts
- Clothing (at least 2 new w/tags/pkg): Socks, T-shirts, underwear, warm hat, gloves, warm outerwear, scarf, ball cap, etc.
