<u>Deacon Emeritus Program</u>

Deacon Emeritus is a pilot program approved by the church at the June business meeting to begin immediately. We are hopeful that this vote to approve six senior deacons will provide a means of further ministry, particularly to our older church members and those who may be hospitalized or in assisted care. We are also hopeful that the wisdom of older men with more than 20 years experience and service in the past can be passed on to our young deacons through a mentoring process.

We have several new deacons this year who have

no prior experience as a deacon. We would hope that the deacon emeritus program would enable these older men to reach out to young deacons either over coffee or through conversation in an informal setting. It is important that our new deacons come to understand their own gifts and abilities to minister in their life journey.

The church in a regular business meeting will vote in Spring 2023 to decide if this program becomes a permanent addition to our church organization.

We welcome Sam Chandler, Bucky Dalton, Ralph Evitts, Bill Kayse, Don Swindler, and Ron Waldridge to this new ministry.
