A word from your pastor....

My beloved church family,

We live in a changing world and our church demographics have been in flux. Once we were known as the church of the affluent. Things are very different today. In times like our First Responder Weekend, the Bicentennial and Palm Sunday, we came together as a united family of faith. There was a vitality that was electrifying. Bringing the family together as one in worship side by side was a beautiful thing. The children sang side by side with our precious senior saints. I believe we are better together!

At our recent business meeting, I shared a vision of what might be. I would love to see our family coming together regularly, with both the praise team and the choir unified in powerful worship of our Lord. What might this look like? Personal preferences will have to be subordinated to what it will take to reach our community for Christ. If everyone compromises a bit, we might well be able to see younger families jump in and serve the Lord alongside us. And our seniors will interact with young families. At the same time, we must celebrate the rich heritage of our church family and sing some of the great songs of the faith. I truly believe we would be better together.

Now, having cast a vision of what might be, our church is empanelling a five member committee to study this proposition. They represent an even split between the

discussion for those not engaged in Bible Study. If this is not the time for change, that may be the case. If flipping the two formats works better, blessed be the name of the Lord. And, if combining the formats enhances the synergy of the body and helps us better reach Shelby County, all the better. Our body of believers will collectively seek the face of the Lord. That is paramount.

As your pastor, I would ask for this one consideration. We are a family, and everyone is important and significant. Whatever your opinions may be, express them with love and respect for the whole body to the glory of the Lord. As a church family, whatever we may do in the short term or in the long term, the health of the body and the glory of our Savior must be our collective goals. I love serving the Lord alongside you. I am privileged to be your pastor. And I love you all . . . regardless of which service you attend. God is at work already. And I trust Him to reveal Himself to us as a church family.


